Notice pursuant to ss 45 and 464 of the *Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW)*

On 29 May 2025, Council of the Law Society of New South Wales (**Council**) considered your application for renewal of your practising certificate for the period 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025.

Council resolved that:

- a. it was of the opinion that you were not a fit and proper person to hold a practising certificate.
- b. being of that opinion, pursuant to s 45 of the *Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW)* (**Uniform Law**), refused to renew your practising certificate for the period 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025.

Please find enclosed a Notice issued pursuant to ss 45 and 464 of the Uniform Law (**Notice**) which provides notice of Council's decision and its reasons.

As your practising certificate was not renewed, you are not entitled to engage in legal practice.

I draw your attention to the rights of review in the Notice.
